In the past year alone, ADOC has been put on nd<u>tRe@egyathment of Ju</u>sbigethe <u>Equal Justice Initia</u>tby<u>Alabamians for Fair Justime</u> by<u>thepres</u>that their prisons are the deadliest in the coulling. and time again ADOC has committed to new forms of internal oversight, and new strategic plassicetion the midst of this heightened scrutiny that these latest deaths have occurred.

To signal its commitment to accountability and tra**aspanians**yfor Fair Justice calls upon Commissioner Duand Governor Iveginclude independent, external observers on any new task force on prison violence. At the least, these observers should include:

- Legislators with experience on the prison coversignee
- Advocates who have served time in ADOC prisons
- Lawyers who represent people in prison
- Family members of people who have been victims of violence in ADOC prisons
- Currently incarcerated advocates

We welcome ADOC to discuss the composition of it
