

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Service Provider shall provide U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) with

SERVICES: The Service Provider shall house data entries pursuant to the issuance and acceptance of

§ 2341 and either a "Form I-90 (Warrant for Arrest of Alien) or Form I-205 (Warrant of Removal) or a "Form I-205-A (Warrant of Removal) as prescribed by the Board of Immigration Appeals in accordance with the provisions of 8 CFR 2341.3(b) of the Federal Regulations.

ORDERS: Only ICE purchase card holders have the authority to order against this POA. Under no circumstance shall an order exceed \$2,500.00.

A copy accompanied by Form 247, "Information Sheet," Notice of Appeal, and Form 248.

DETENTION: Detention under Section 14(1)(b) and 14(1)(c) of the Act will be limited to 48 hours unless otherwise ordered by a court or detention. No payment will be made for any detention beyond 48 hours, except as provided in the Act.
