The Service Provider shall provide U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) with

SERVICES: The Service Provider shall house detainees in accordance with the acceptance of ICE and enter a Form I-200 (Warrant for Arrest of Alien) or Form I-205 (Warrant of Detention) in accordance with ICE and Federal Regulations.

ORDERS: Only ICE purchase card holders have the authority to order against this BOA. Under no circumstance shall an order exceed \$2,500.00
