JOINT NOTICE OF AGREEMENT REGARDING PRODUCTIONS  
RELATING TO PEOPLE WITH SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS IN  
RESTRICTIVE HOUSING

The Parties hereby notify the Court of the following agreement document  
productions relating to people with serious mental illness in restrictive housing:

1. [Starting November 1, 2019] Wexford will perform an audit of the 7-day  
assessments contained in the RHU Order (doc. 18-154) to determine if  
the 7-day assessments are being timely and properly completed.
  - a. A random sampling of the 7-day assessments for 10% of the inmates for  
whom 7-day assessments were completed system will be forwarded  
to the Director of Psychiatry at Wexford Health Sources, Inc. or any

- Wexford regional office clinician(s) and quality assurance personnel designated by Wexford's Director of Psychiatry for this purpose on a monthly basis.
- b. The sampling of 7day assessments should include, but not be limited to, inmates in the RHU who are coded as ~~101~~ and not flagged as SMI.
  - c. As part of its continuous quality improvement program, Wexford will review the 7day assessments using audit tools developed by Wexford and will develop any necessary corrective action plans.
  - d. Wexford will report the results of its audit of 7day assessments and send the underlying 7day assessments to ADOC's Office of Health Services (OHS) on a quarterly basis. ADOC's OHS will review the report and underlying documents to determine whether any additional corrective action is necessary.
  - e. If additional corective action is necessary, ADOC's OHS will request Wexford prepare and/or revise a corrective action plan and implement such plan.
  - f. Plaintiffs' counsel will be provided Wexford's quarterly report, the underlying 7day assessments, ADOC's response to ~~Wexf~~ audits, any further correspondence between ADOC and Wexford on the audits or
